## TIMETABLE & SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES

## 2023 BAYELSA, IMO AND KOGI STATE GOVERNORSHIP ELECTIONS

By virtue of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (as amended), the tenure of the Governors of Imo, Kogi and Bayelsa States will expire on the 14th day of January, 26th day of January and 13th day of February 2024 respectively.

VOTE

Pursuant to Sections 178 (2) of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 (as amended), elections to the said office shall hold not earlier than One Hundred and Fifty (150) days and not later than Thirty (30) days before the expiration of the term of office of the last holder of that office.

The Commission is empowered by Section 28(1) of the Electoral Act 2022 to issue Notice for the elections not later than Three Hundred and Sixty (360) days before the date of the elections.

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Independent National Electoral Commission (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") by the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (as amended) and the Electoral Act, 2022 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Commission hereby issues this Timetable and Schedule of Activities for 2023 Governorship Elections in Bayelsa, Imo and Kogi States.
